Our exciting acting curriculum varies in intensity with age, experience, and length of session. Acting is at the core of everything we teach and it takes a lifetime to master.

Story Drama

Bring a storybook to life by exploring motivations, choices, and actions while creating dialogue and improvising scenes.

Playmakers

Use improvisation and theater games to create a story and develop your own theatrical masterpiece.

Scene Study

Dive into a script while you put your acting skills to work bringing the characters on the page to life on the stage.

Voice & Movement

Build strength, flexibility, awareness, and expression through a class devoted to the fundamentals of two of the actor's most important tools.

Musical Theater

Increase your versatility and work on new vocal and dance techniques while exploring the art of telling a story through words, music, and movement.

One-week & two-week sessions at MYAC – Serving new and returning students entering grades 3-12 in Fall 2025

Designed for students on the autism spectrum, Next Steps classes help students take their next steps as an artist and a person. First Stage creates a safe space for all students to express themselves and develop as individuals without judgment or fear of failure. Guided by our philosophy of teaching “Life Skills Through Stage Skills,” students will experience the joy of theater arts each day with a team of teaching artists and special education professionals.

Class Sizes: 8 students; our classroom model includes teams of lead teachers, special education professionals, and teaching assistants with approximately a 2:1 student to teacher ratio. Family aides may accompany a student to class as necessary and agreed upon between the family and First Stage.

How do I register for First Stage Theater Academy?

All registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis, accepted by mail, fax, or online at [firststage.org](https://www.firststage.org). Please register as early as possible, as space fills quickly. Please complete all information on your registration form to ensure your registration is processed as soon as possible.

Will I receive a confirmation of my registration?

Confirmations are sent via email for the class(es) for which you have registered. Please read your confirmation thoroughly when you receive it.

Is there a waitlist for classes that are full?

Waitlists are established for classes that have reached the enrollment limit. Students on waitlists may be called for enrollment should a cancellation occur. While we cannot predict when or if a cancellation would occur, we encourage you to be added to our waitlists, which are created on a first-come, first-served basis.

What does my tuition include and when is my tuition due?

Tuition includes all materials and one Academy t-shirt per student. A \$75 minimum deposit for Summer Academy is required with your registration. Any remaining balances will be deducted automatically on Friday, May 23, 2025, unless you are on an automatic payment schedule for the balance. Automatic payment schedules must be scheduled with our office staff, failure to make scheduled payments may result in removal from your students class. Can my child switch a class?

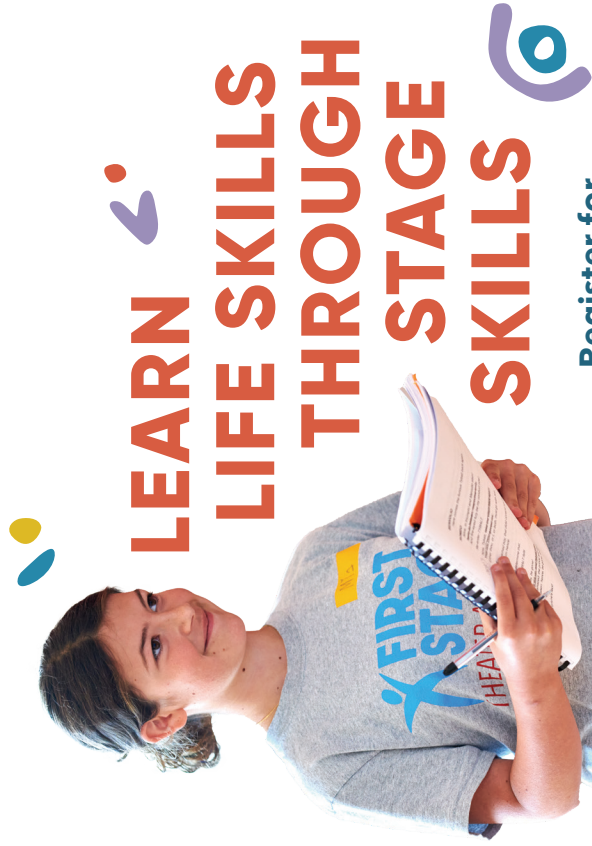
