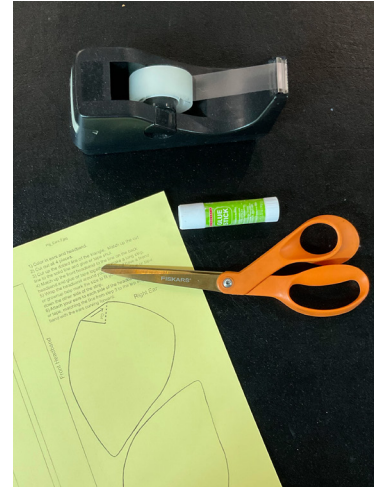


# CREATE YOUR VERY OWN PIGGIE OR WOLF EARS HEADBAND, SO YOU CAN ACT OUT THE DIFFERENT ROLES IN THE STORY:

What you'll need:

- a print out of the ear patterns
- colored pencils, crayons or markers
- scissors
- glue or tape
- a grown-up or friend to help

1) Color in your ears and headband however you'd like!



2) Cut out all the pieces. You should have 3 strips for your headband and 2 ear pieces for each set of ears.

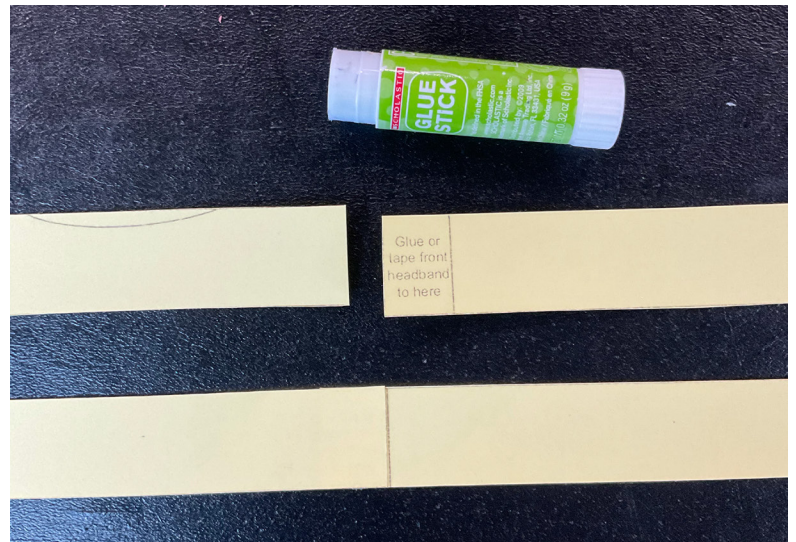
3) On each ear piece, cut up the dotted line on the triangles. One on each pig ear and two on each wolf ear.

- put a smear of glue on the triangle, then bring the dotted line you just cut over to meet the solid line and hold in place for a bit until the glue sets - or use a piece of tape on the back side to hold the triangle closed.



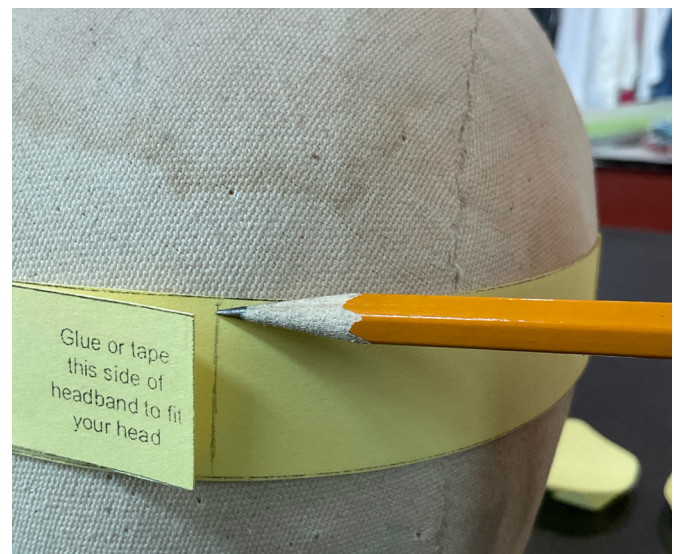
4) Set the ears aside to dry and pick up your 3 headband pieces. For the pig ears, the front piece is plain. For the wolf ears, the front piece has two curved lines drawn on the top edge.

- put some glue or tape on the section marked “glue or tape front headband here” and match up the edge of the front piece to the line -



Repeat on both sides to make one long strip with all 3 pieces.

5) Wrap the strip around your head and have a grown-up or friend help mark the strip to fit your head. Glue or tape the edge down.

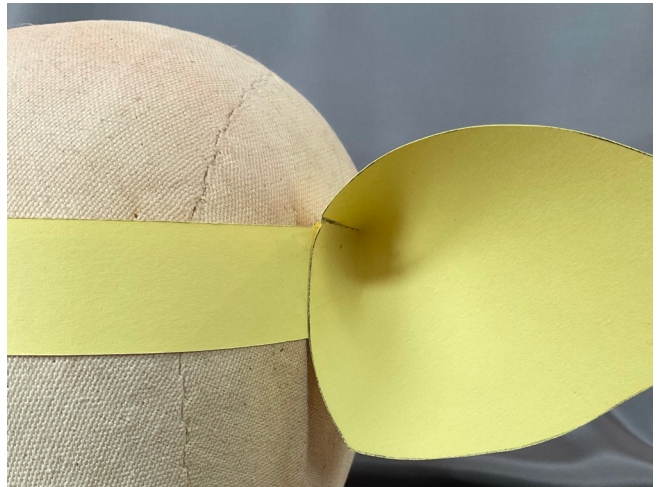




## 6) Attach your ears!

-For the pig ears, apply some glue or tape right at the edge where you attached the front headband to the sides. Place the triangle you closed up in step 3 right at the top of the headband.

Repeat on the other side.



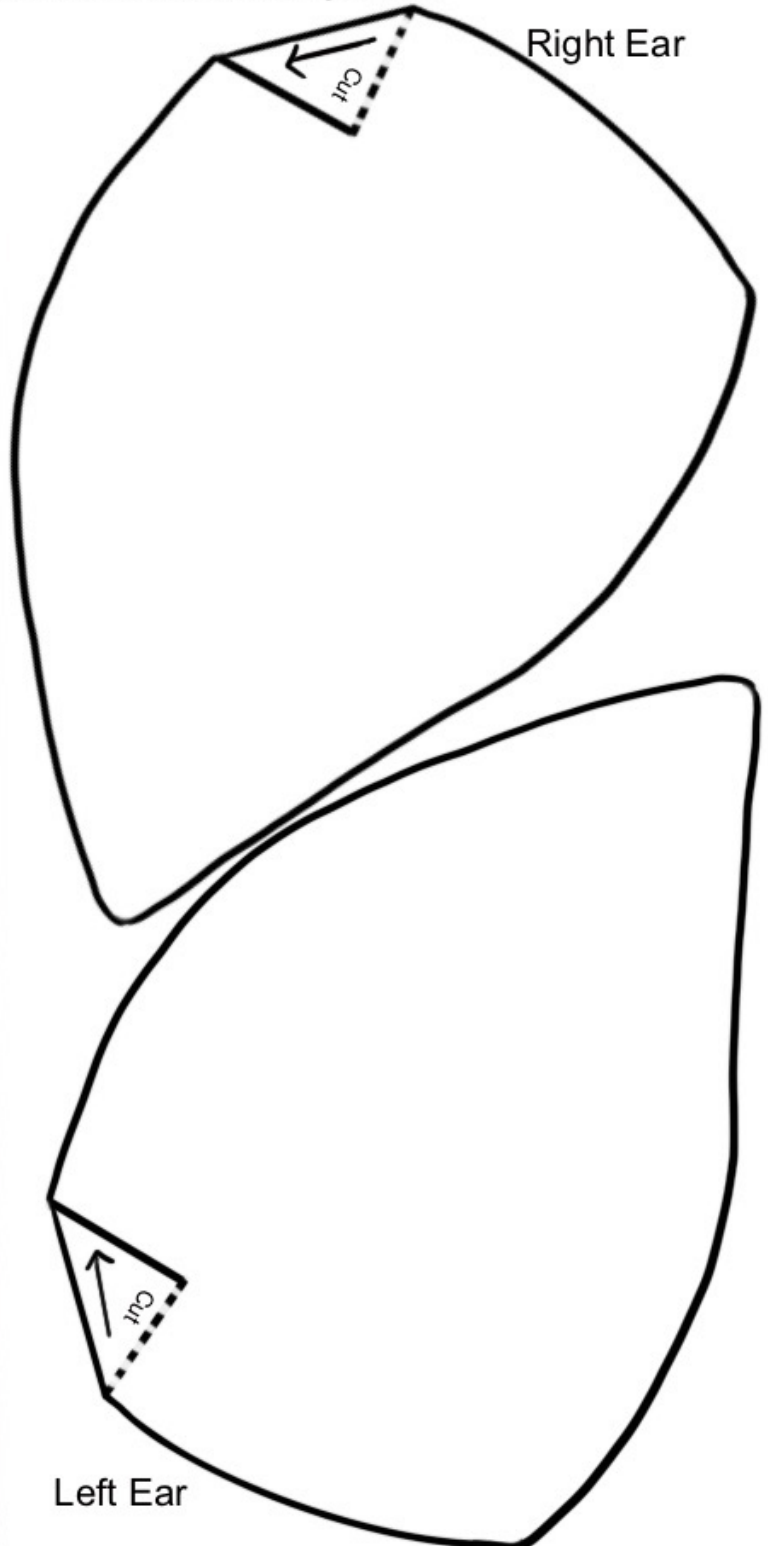
-For the wolf, apply some glue inside the curved lines at the top of the headband. Attach the ears inside the lines on each side.



# Pig Ears

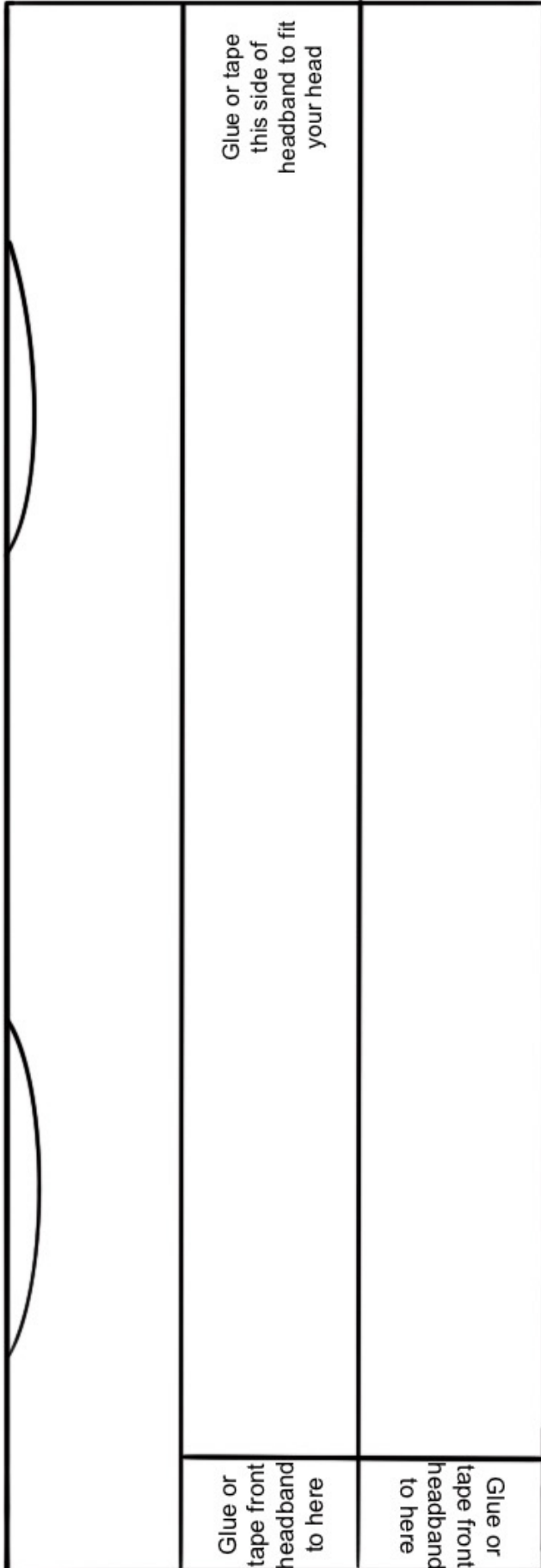
- 1) Color in ears and headband.
- 2) Cut out all 5 pieces.
- 3) Cut up the dotted line of the triangle. Match up the cut line to the solid line and glue or tape shut.
- 4) Match up the front headband to the lines on the back headbands and glue or tape together to make a long strip.
- 5) Wrap the headband around your head and have a friend or grownup help mark the size to fit your head. Glue or tape down the other side of the strip.
- 6) Attach your ears to each side of the headband with glue or tape, matching the line from step 3 to the top edge of the band with the ears curving forward.

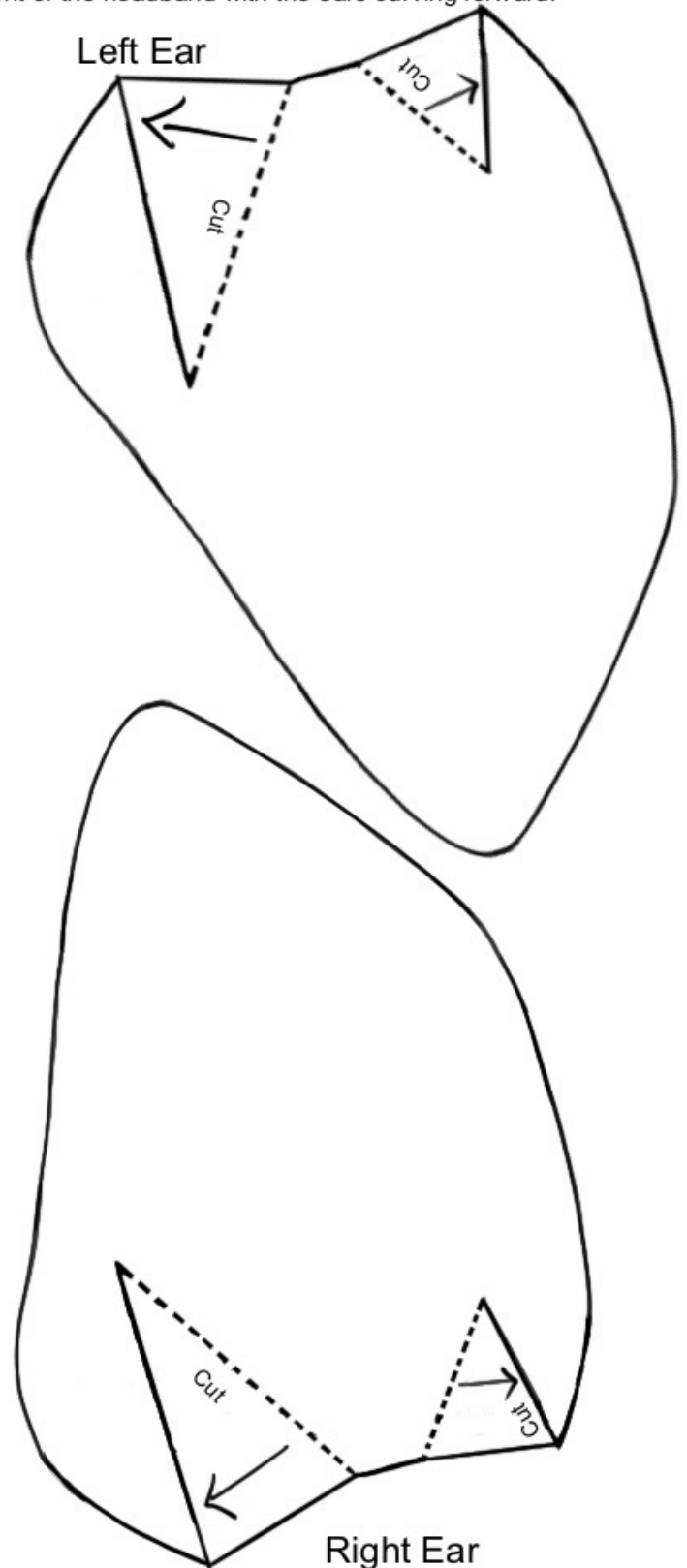




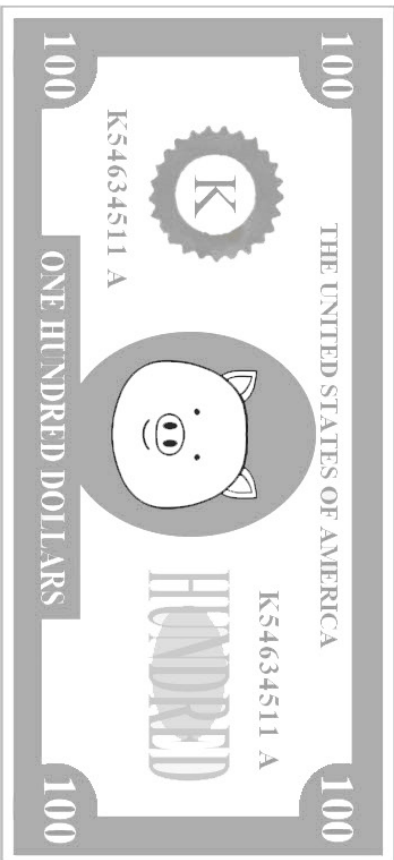
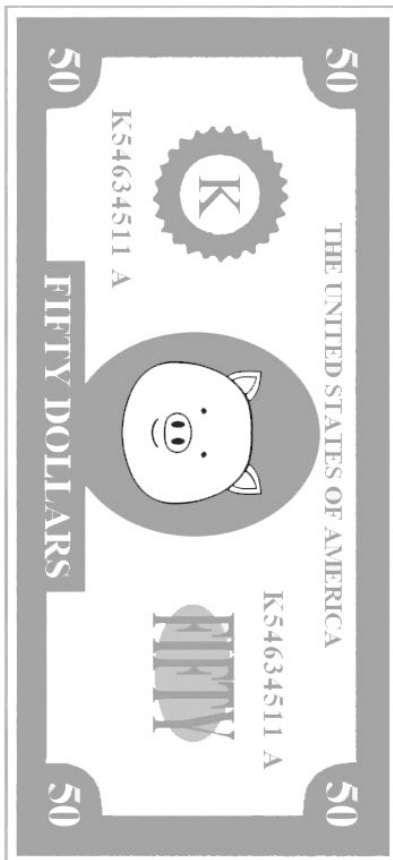
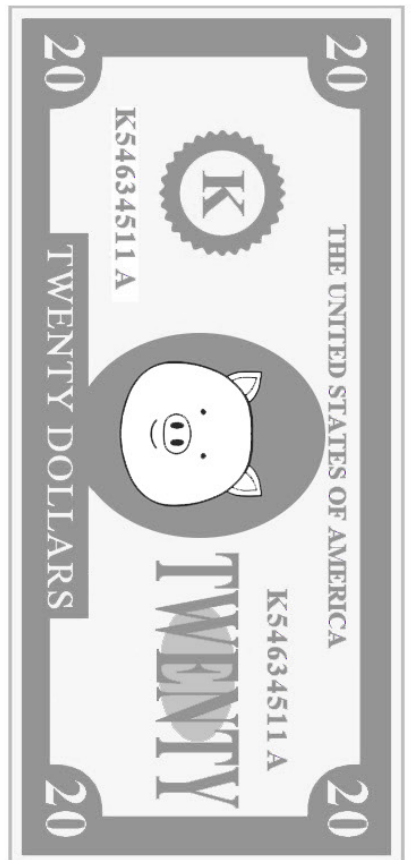
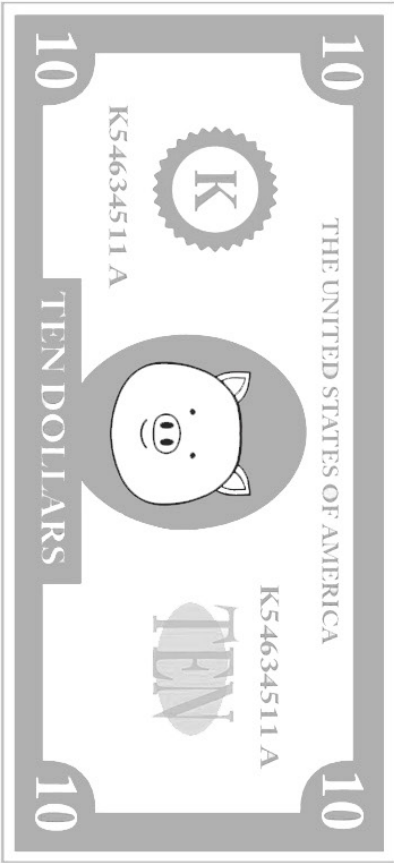
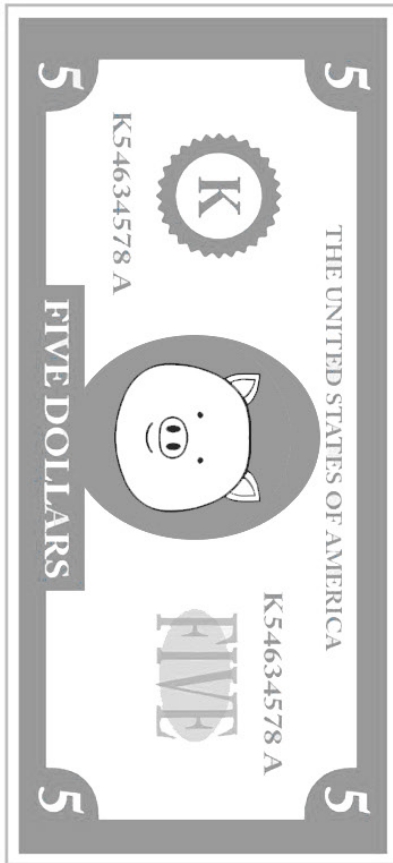
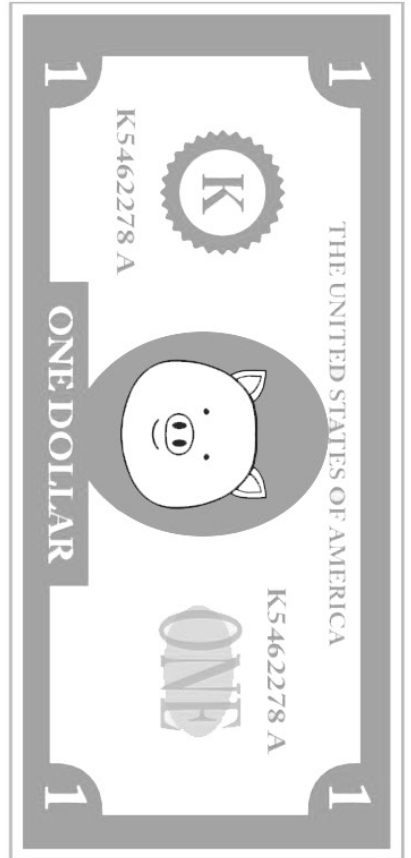
# Wolf Ears



- 1) Color ears and headband
- 2) Cut out all 5 pieces.
- 3) Cut along the dotted lines and then match the cut line over to the solid line. Glue or tape shut.
- 4) Glue or tape each side of the front headband to make a long strip.
- 5) Wrap headband around your head and have a grown up or friend help mark the size you need. Glue or tape together to make a circle that fits your head.
- 6) Attach the ears to the headband on the lines marked on the front of the headband with the ears curving forward.
